



VOLUNTEER JOB DESCRIPTION

POSITION: Drum Circle Facilitator

OBJECTIVE: Represent Gilda's Club and guide the Camp Kesem campers through a drum circle experience of rhythm and community building

ROLE DESCRIPTION:

- Working with the Program Coordinator, determine how to adapt the experience to the needs of youth impacted by cancer through the diagnosis of a parent or loved one at Camp Kesem
- Coordinate details of the session with program coordinator in advance including transportation of equipment (Gilda's Club to provide all drums & handheld percussive instruments)
- Lead drumming circle for approximately 15 campers: create a group rhythm, provide an outlet for expression, and encourage the spirit of camaraderie and community
- Assess the abilities of your students to ensure they can participate in the class with or without options that adapt to their physical or emotional needs
- Demonstrate a positive attitude and energy through a display of courtesy, service, cooperation, hospitality, sensitivity, and professionalism to Camp Kesem campers
- Above all, make the experience fun and enjoyable for all Camp Kesem campers

SKILLS:

- Certification or expertise in the following areas: drum circle facilitation, music therapy or music therapy intern
- Excellent communication skills
- Ability to lead, motivate and engage a group
- Ability and enthusiasm to work with children and teens

BENEFITS:

- Work closely with a dedicated and passionate group of people
- Ability to further develop and utilize your skills in support of those impacted by cancer
